Job Description

Job Title: Middle School Student Pastor

Purpose Statement:

The role of the Middle School Student Pastor is to oversee and execute the mission of Fellowship Bible Church in the Student Ministry (FSM) for grades 5th – 7th.

Responsibilities – The Middle School Student Pastor role has a wide range of responsibility and reports to the Executive Pastor, while working closely with the High School Pastor.

Student Ministry

- Relationally engage students through formal (Sunday/Wednesday) and informal (discipleship/hanging out/campus time) times together.
- Teach expository messages during Wednesday worship services that are engaging and relevant to students.
- Prepare and lead Sunday morning Bible study time (current format).
- Recruit and equip small group leaders for Midweek (small groups).
- Communicate upcoming events and information consistently.
- Lead an annual weekend retreat for Middle School.
- Help prepare, lead, and execute an annual mission trip to Mission Arlington.

Planning & Administration

- Plan a yearly ministry calendar for Middle School.
- Develop a Middle School spending plan that funds the ministry.
- Strategically have events throughout the year that build relationships and community within Middle School.
- Empower admin staff to provide administrative help to with Middle School.

Missions

- Plan and execute a cross-cultural mission trip for the FSM (Mission Arlington)
 - Research and solidify mission trips
 - Make a spending plan for mission trips
 - Provide applications for mission trips
 - Recruit participants for mission trips
 - Train teams for mission trips
 - Lead or empower leaders for mission trips
 - Plan and execute fundraisers for mission trips

Work Schedule: 40+ hours per week.
